- First conditioning, clear coat is applied to front face, back and two edges.

- The second is a color coat that is applied to the front-finished face.

• Applied Finish: Broda Clarity Acrylic, Water-borne, low V.O.C, film-building finish.

• Color: Broda Clarity 117 White Wash
